PREPARATION AND GLOBAL ORGANISATION OF THE INCOMING MOBILITY

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- A school project: involvement of the director, the managers of the section, the general and technical trainers, the students, the companies
- Communication and division of the tasks and responsibilities
- 3 aspects managed by the school:
 - pedagogical aspect
 - logistic aspect
 - administrative aspect

PREPARATION AND GLOBAL ORGANISATION OF THE INCOMING MOBILITY

- **Anna Rey**: pedagogical and quality projects officer and **mobility adviser** (dedicated time)
 - contact with the partner (objective of the project, participants, pedagogical expectations, dates)
 - administrative organisation: presence of minors, insurance procedure, learning agreements, participation certification
 - program and agenda
 - logistics: finding accomodation solutions, local transports, board, organisation of the welcoming and closing events

PREPARATION AND GLOBAL ORGANISATION OF THE INCOMING MOBILITY

- **Pedagogical staff:** in charge of contacting the companies for the « internship week »
- **Teachers and technical trainers:** pedagogical content of the mobility
- **Units:** air conditioning system, suspension and customer reception
- 1st experience of **co-teaching:** teams of English teachers and technical trainers for the preparation of the modules and during the class



PREPARATION AND GLOBAL ORGANISATION OF THE INCOMING MOBILITY

- Involvement of **students**: students divided by pairs (one Italian student with one French student)
- French students as « tutors » of the Italian students, especially in the companies
- Great experience: speed up bonding between the students ; higher responsibility and autonomy of the students
