1_LAB HIDDEN AND INTERNATIONAL COMPETENCES: Miika Kekki, University of Helsinki (SALA...)

The laboratory is aimed at discovering what hidden and international skills are carriers through life experiences and learning. Each individual is characterized by knowledge and skills that bring him to a dimension of comparison with each other and with different cultures, often it is skills and

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knowledge of which we are not aware. The aim of the workshop is to find out how to bring out these "hidden" abilities and how to enhance them in order to make them valuable and precious in the labor market, in the educational world and in general in the eyes of the community in which we act our daily

2_LAB VIRTUAL LEARNING MOBILITY : Francesca Helm, Unicollaboration, University of Padova (SALA...)

The laboratory aims to provide a definition of virtual mobility and virtual exchanges (virtual mobility vs virtual exchanges). Virtuality in learning mobility is presented today as an alternative to geographical and physical mobility, but implies methodological and didactic conditions that are the object of analysis. Therefore the laboratory is designed to understand how virtual mobility is positioned within a learning path, such as hardware and software technological tools are able to support it, which educational and training objectives can be intercepted through its use.

3.LAB DIGITAL BADGE, Lucia Mancino, UNISER (SALA...)

The laboratory is aimed at learning the virtual badge tool, as a certification tool and certification of certain skills. Today virtual badges are closely connected with the certification of skills and transversal skills (soft skills) and are particularly appreciated by young people who can use them in ways that are easily transferable within their social profiles. In certain university experiences the badge replaces the credits in the optional courses, but the badges can potentially attract the world of vocational training in the valorization of "informal" learning in contexts such as foreign mobility.
