



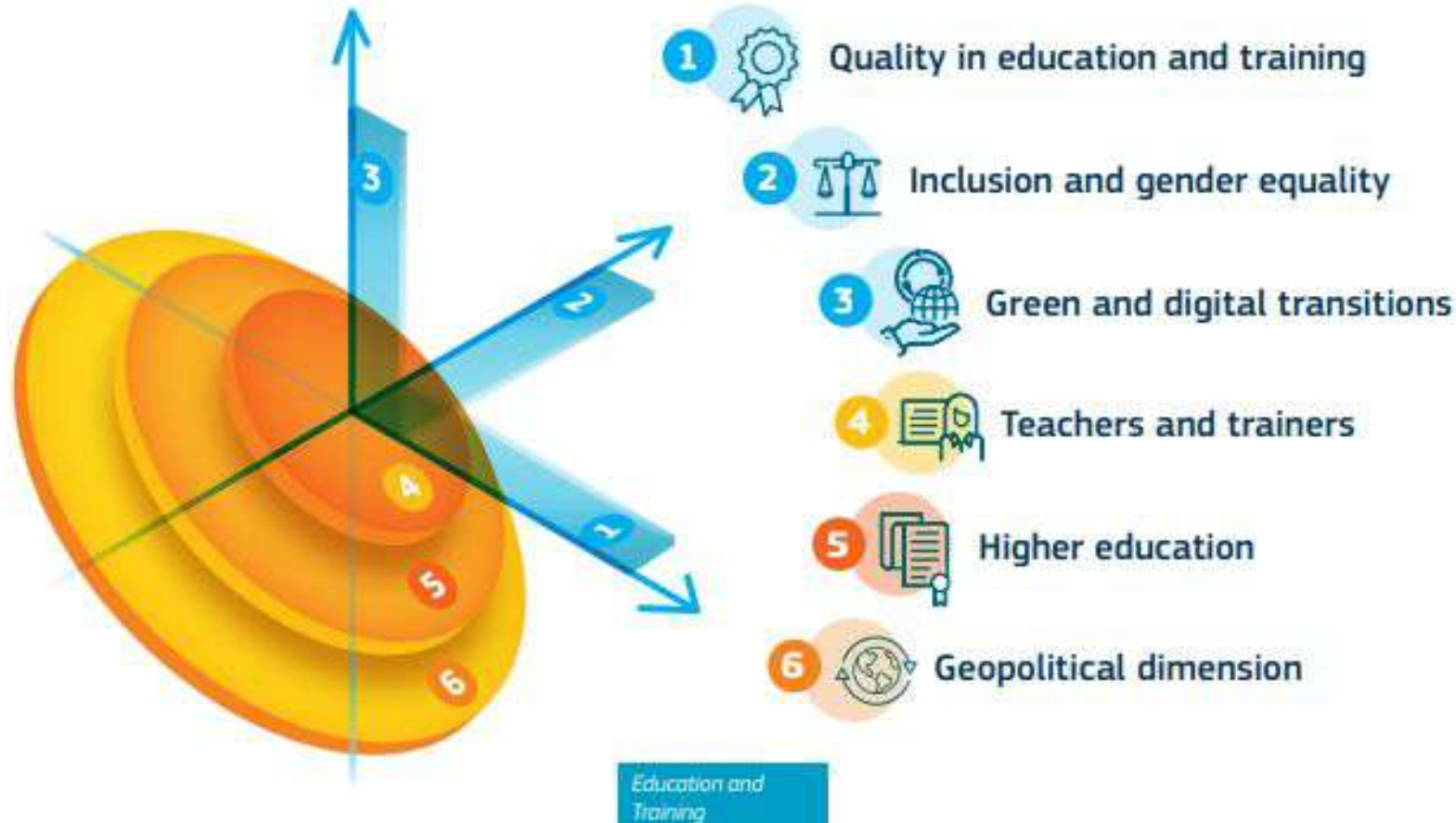

The six dimensions of the EEA are :

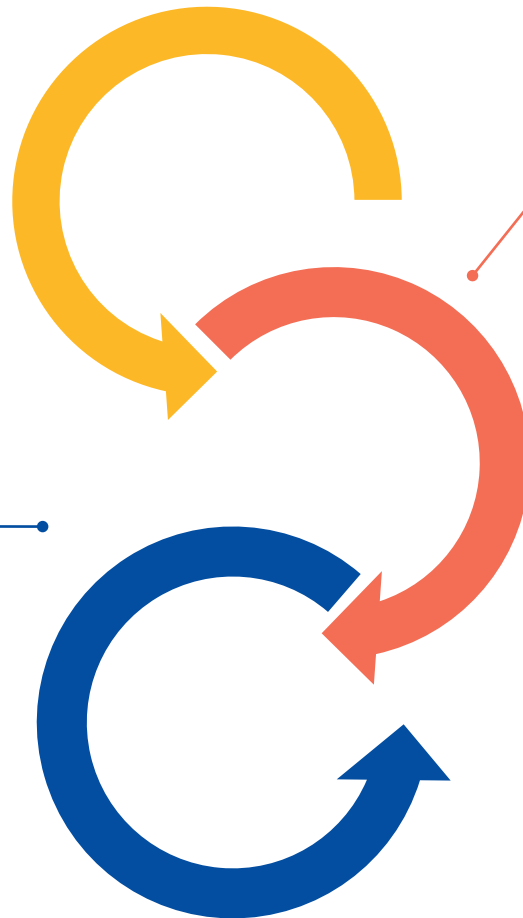


Make quality and borderless learning available for all

VET promotes European vocational education and training systems in an international context so that they are recognised as a worldwide reference of excellence

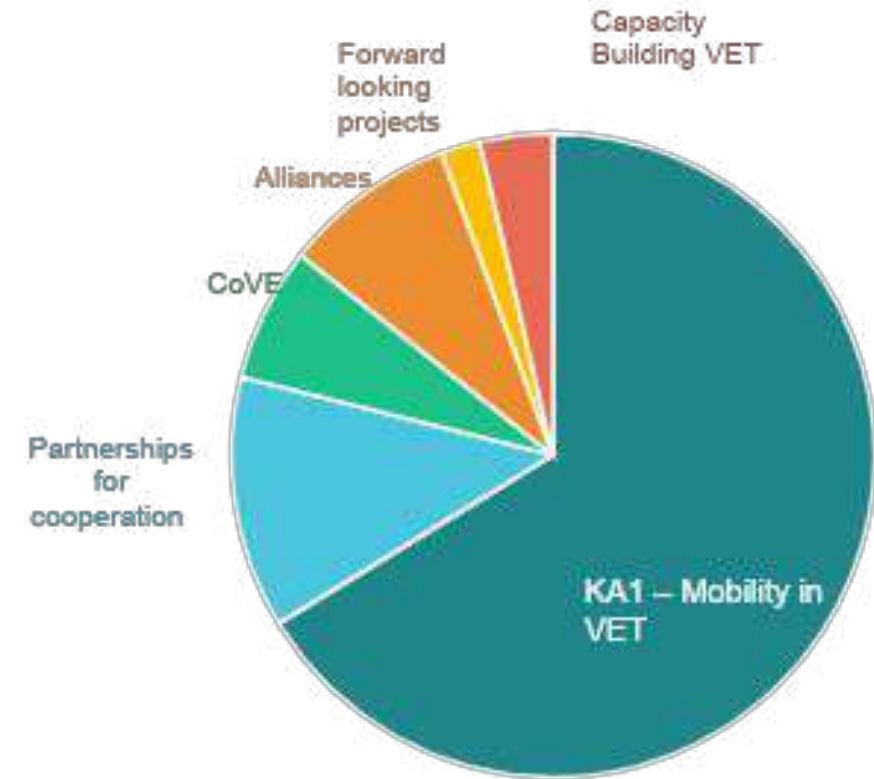


VET fosters inclusiveness and equal opportunities and contributes to achieving resilience, social fairness and prosperity

# Erasmus+ KA1 - Accreditations

Accreditations are motivated by the goals of the **European Education Area**

In practice, it means:

- Scaling up and mainstreaming mobility
- Building the capacity of individual organisations
- Building a European network of education sector actors



# Erasmus accreditations 2020 – some figures

- 91,5% of VET charter holders applied for re-accreditation
- 75% total success rate □ 2.962 accreditations awarded in the VET field
- 18% Consortium type
- 119 regional and local public bodies as consortium coordinators
- n° of accreditations ≠ n° of organisations □ 7112 organisations
- 76% of the accredited organisations applied for funding on 2021
